Day 1: Meet at the Linn Grove Dam at 9:00am. This float will end near Wanata Park in Peterson.

Day 2: Meet at the Prairie Heritage Center at 9:00am. This float will end at Martins Access.

Each float will take 5-7 hours to complete depending on weather and water conditions.
