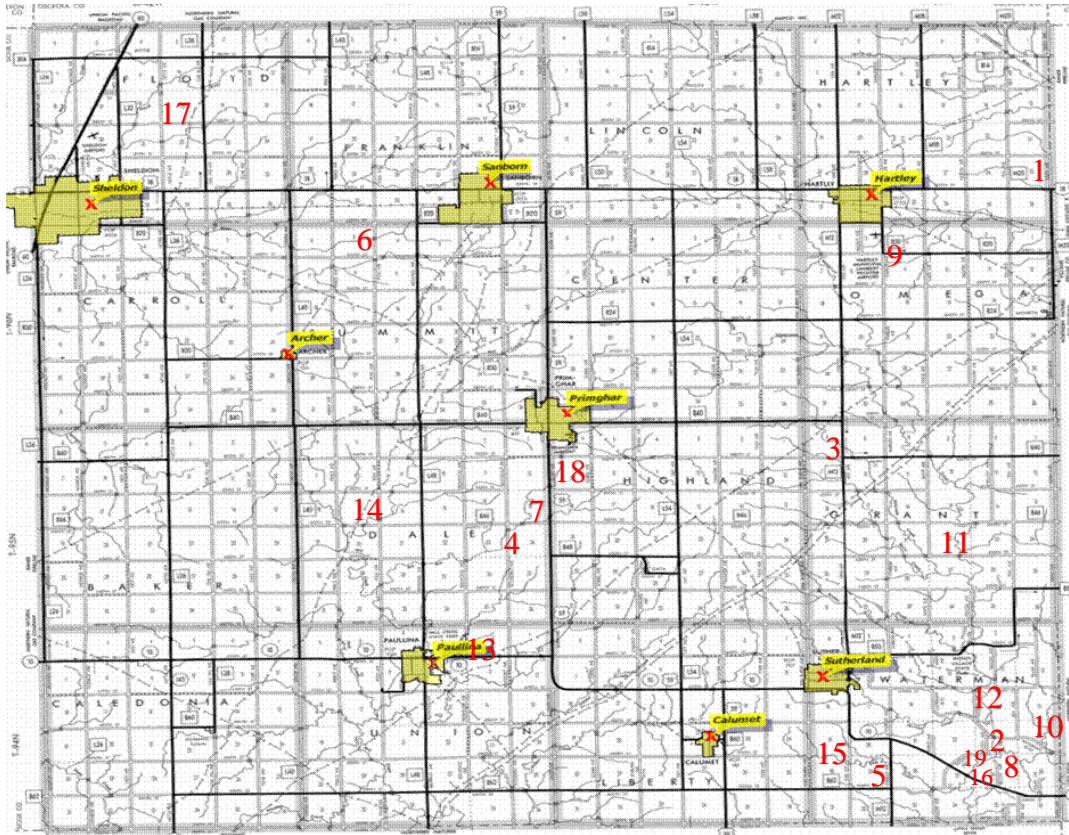


Get to Know O'Brien County Conservation Board Areas - Summer 2020
