The O'Brien County Conservation Board met in special session at the Prairie Heritage Center at 5:30 p.m. In attendance were: Sherri Bootsma, Royd Chambers, Kathy Luedke, Jack Wallinga and Darwin Dau. Mari Radtke was present as a visitor.

The meeting was held at the suggestion of County Auditor Barb Rohwer after she gave the board notice that language used in a motion adopted at the November 11, 2020 meeting regarding longevity pay for Terry Boltjes would need to be clarified.

Moved by Luedke, seconded by Bootsma, the motion adopted at the regular O'Brien County Conservation Board meeting on November 11, 2020 which reads as "The O'Brien County Conservation Board awards Terry Boltjes \$3000.00 and his service weapon" is amended to "The O'Brien County Conservation Board approves the expenditure of \$3000.00 longevity pay to Terry Boltjes. The Board minutes adopted on September 17, 2003 stipulated "Every fifth year thereafter the Director is eligible for a \$1,000.00 longevity increase." Motion carried, unanimous.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:00 p.m. The next meeting will be Wednesday, December 9, 2020 at the Prairie Heritage Center.
