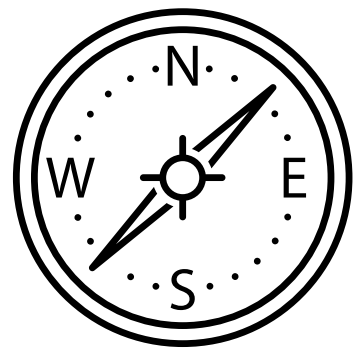

Nature Trekking | We are going on an adventure! Campers will learn orienteering skills and put those skills to use as we go on a trek through the prairie. On this great trek they will also look for signs of animals and build a shelter. It will be a wild adventure!

Outdoor Quest | August 2-3, 2021

Campers will learn about hunting, trapping, bird identification, and dog training. There will be a field day for the hunter safety education course offered through the Iowa DNR. *To receive a certification, a student must successfully complete an Iowa approved online Hunter Education Course prior to registration.*

Campers will stay overnight at Dog Creek Park in the grain bin cabins. Evening activities will include Dutch oven cooking, water recreation, night tracking, and astronomy.

This camp program is for youth who have not attended in the past and are interested in obtaining their hunter safety certification. Space is limited to 11 boys and 11 girls.
